Discussion:

- Principal thanked the parents for committing to our Coffee Morning every week as this has been labeled as a great success to the school during the latest inspection.
- The number of cases is decreasing daily however the pandemic is still on and we must always follow the precautions and protocols. Principal updated parents about the latest protocols. Contacts of positive cases are no longer requested to quarantine however they must test depending on the age group. We haven't received directives from ADEK yet regarding not using the mask in the playground. We always comply with ADEK guidance and we do not take any procedure without going back to ADEK.
- Principal advised parents to vaccinate their children in order to combat the pandemic and help the school reach the Blue tier which will ease Covid-19 restrictions in school.
- AC temperature is set to 24 in classes
- Year 5 to Year 13 will go on EXPO Trips from March 9th to March 24th. The reason we will not take below Year 5 is because we were not allowed to use buses with toilets. Parents will receive all info prior to the trips.
- We have done various bullying awareness sessions for students by Abu Dhabi Police and we will work to hold bullying awareness workshops for parents too.
- FS1 Extracurricular clubs will be launched soon.
- Year 5, Year 7, Year 9, and Year 11 students will take the EMSAT test in English, Arabic, Science and Math subjects. We are waiting the MOE update regarding the new dates.
- A Zoom session will be held for Y10, 11, 12 parents to explain the Ministerial decision 883 related to Y13 equivalency which will be effective from the AY 2022/2023.
