### **Discussion:**

- Cases are rising after the winter break, the school principal asked parents to keep cautious and follow all the correct protocols in order to stop the spread of the virus.
- Principal asked parents' cooperation by vaccinating their children so that the school reaches the blue tier.
- The timetables have been amended to be in line with the new working week and half day on Friday. Students lost 70 minutes of learning on Fridays and the school compensated this loss in other week days by reducing non-core subjects' periods.

- We've had a great start for Term2 Face to Face learning for FS1 students and attendance is rising day by day as some students could not join due to the delay in PCR results.
- Principal explained that the work the students are asked to complete in each subject is the daily classwork done in class and it is not assignments. Therefore, the teacher uses the daily classwork in order to check the student's understanding of the subject to move forward with the lesson planning.
