Discussion:

- The school trips to Expo were very successful. Students enjoyed themselves and represented the school in a very positive way. More trips to go next week.
- Principal updated parents about the current situation, cases are decreasing daily. Very rare cases in AJIS. Contacts with positive cases are no longer required to quarantine. Masks are no longer required in outdoor areas.
- Principal advised parents to vaccinate their children in order to combat the pandemic and help the school reach the Blue tier which will ease Covid-19 restrictions in school.
- Excessive absence and lateness negatively affects the academic performance of the child. It also negatively impacts the attendance percentage which must be at least 96% throughout the academic year (not more than 8 days of absence during the whole academic year). Principal advised parents to train their children on specific routines which will help them to be responsible individuals in the future.
- Principal reminded parents of the uniform and appearance policy. He advised them to monitor their children's appearance daily in the morning before they leave to school. Appearance policy will be strictly implemented in Term 3.
- Principal reminded parents to re-register their children in order to reserve their seats for the Academic Year 2022/2023.
- Principal shared the school social media links with parents to follow and share.
- The school promotes Healthy eating. Students are encouraged not to bring unhealthy food during events and celebrations.
- Principal explained to Secondary parents that the reasons behind having two exams on some days are having to go on Expo trips and a lot of events towards the end of term.
