

AGREEMENT OF EXPECTATIONS FOR VIDEO CONFERENCING LESSONS

AJYAL INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL – MBZ

This document outlines the expectations for all students who are engaging with Video Conferencing lessons while students at the AJYAL INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL (AJIS-MBZ).

By joining any AJIS-MBZ video conferencing session, this signifies that these expectations have been agreed and will be adhered to.

- AJIS students who are part of a video conferencing session will still adhere to all the Digital Acceptable Use Policy guidelines.
- AJIS students will not take part in a video conference session while in their bedrooms - they should be in a non-private part of their home, or in a public area (see below).
- If a public area is chosen as a location, the AJIS student must ensure that it is an appropriate area, and that they are not disturbing any members of the public.
- AJIS students must be dressed appropriately for the session - clothes that would be appropriate for a shopping mall should be the guidance on what to wear.
- AJIS students must behave appropriately to the member(s) of staff, and to each other during the video conferencing session - normal school expectations of behaviour apply.
- Students should be only focusing on the session - it is not appropriate to multi-task with other media/devices during a session.
- It is not acceptable for an AJIS student to record a video conference session in any way, nor to share any pre-recorded messages outside of AJIS.
- It is not acceptable to invite anyone who is not an AJIS student into the session without prior approval.
- Please use Video Conferencing sessions as an opportunity to ask questions directly to your teacher, it is a way of you being able to get instant feedback that will support you in your learning.
